Healing Field helps fight child abuse

SAVANNAH, GA (WTOC) - Starting Friday, 1,666 American flags will be on display at the National Guard Armory in Savannah.

Each flag in the Healing Field represents a child who was abused in Chatham County last year. Volunteers from the Old Savannah City Mission and the NJROTC program at Johnson High School assembled it on Friday.



"As NJROTC, we represent our U.S. military so the flags in a way represent us and also the kids who are being abused," Lamar Bee said.

The theme this year is "turning a field of hurt into a field of hope" and each time someone buys an American flag it will be replaced by a pinwheel.
