- **Thursday-Sunday , Sept. 8-11, St. John's Evangelical Lutheran Church, 1701 Tiffin Avenue, Findlay, Ohio.**

The Findlay Exchange Club will be host to a **9/11 Healing Field® flag memorial** where you will behold a beautiful display of hundreds of U.S. flags. These 3ft X 5ft flags will stand 8 ft tall in perfect rows. This living display of heroism will fly as a temporary patriotic tribute to the strength and unity of Americans, will commemorate the 10 year anniversary of all those who died September 11, 2001 and honor all military men and women.

- **Thursday Sept. 8 from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. September 11 memorial display at Owens Community College Perrysburg Township. and Findlay campuses**

A memorial display will be at Owens Community College Perrysburg Township and Findlay campuses. Individuals will also have the chance to view the film "**102 Minutes That Changed America**" in the College's Center for Fine and Performing Arts Mainstage Theatre in Perrysburg Township. The 102-minute documentary film depicts in virtually real time the New York-based events of the Sept. 11, 2001 attacks primarily using raw video footage from mostly amateur citizen journalists. Produced by History (channel), the documentary premiered in 2008. "102 Minutes That Changed America" will air continuously from 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. on the Toledo-area Campus.
