Ground Zero – To Lift A Nation is a heroic-size (9ft) bronze monument that depicts the three firemen who raised the American flag at Ground Zero after the attacks on the World Trade Center in New York City.

The photograph of that poignant moment was captured by Thomas E. Franklin a photographer for The Record, a newspaper in North Jersey. World-renowned sculptor, Stan Watts, was granted permission to create a sculpture in the likeness of this photograph. Only three will be created, one of which will stand at Sandy City Hall, and will be dedicated during the 10th Anniversary Healing Field Memorial Flag Display, September 8-13, 2011.

This magnificent monument will serve as a reminder of a day we should never forget. Moreover, it will stand as a symbol of the hope we felt after the day we lost so many... yet stood together.



HEALING FIELD FLAG MEMORIAL SUMMARY

The Healing Field Flag Memorial will be held in Sandy City September 8-13, 2011 and will commemorate the tragic loss that took place 10 years ago with a display of more than 3000 American flags. It will also honor frontline responders in our community and those who serve in the armed forces, risking their lives for the safety and freedom of all American citizens.

The 2011 Healing Field Memorial will also feature a special dedication of a new, unique monument titled, Ground Zero – To Lift A Nation. The monument consists of a magnificent bronze statue that depicts the three firemen who raised the American flag at Ground Zero, after the attacks on the World Trade Center in New York City. The monument will be permanently located in front of Sandy City Hall.

Other highlights of the event include an outdoor musical performance, the state's largest-ever emergency vehicle display, a motorcycle rally, bagpipes, honor guard, the reading of victims' names and a VIP reception with a special nationally-recognized guest to be announced at a later date.
