

Healing Field flags being sold to honor veterans, Sept. 11 victims, responders

HUNTINGTON -- The final day to order a Healing Field flag is Thursday, Sept. 1. Orders can be placed at Huntington's Kitchen, 911 3rd Ave., Huntington, open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily.

Local organizers hope to display 3,000 American flags on several acres at Spring Hill Cemetery to honor veterans, first responders and those who lost their lives in the terrorist attacks on Sept. 11, 2001. Flags will be erected at the cemetery during Labor Day weekend and removed following Sept. 11.

Cost is \$35 each, with proceeds split between the Healing Field Foundation and the Foundation for the Tri-State Community. The Foundation for the Tri-State Community will manage the funds raised to help the Huntington Park and Recreation District build a bell tower at the cemetery, which will serve as a connector on the Paul Ambrose Trail for Health.
