VISITOR AND GUEST INFORMATION

The Healing Field Flag Memorial at Pearl Harbor will help visitors visualize the enormity of the loss as never before. December 7th will mark the 66th anniversary of the attack on at Pearl Harbor.

2408 US Flags will fly on a Healing Field at Richardson Field overlooking the Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor, one flag honoring each US casualty.

In addition to the US Flags, a display of Hawaiian flags will honor Hawaiian citizens and military deployed from Hawaii installations killed in the War on Terrorism.

BENEFITING CHARITIES

The Healing Field memorials and events leave behind a better community by uniting Americans for the greater good. They raise awareness and much needed funds for worthy causes and programs. The proceeds from sponsorship, flag sales and donations will benefit The Pearl Harbor Memorial fund and Military Family Support Fund of Hawaii.

The Pearl Harbor Memorial Fund – The USS Arizona Memorial's museum and visitor center at Pearl Harbor is facing destruction. Engineers have determined that the USS Arizona Memorial's museum & visitor center must be replaced within as few as 2 years before it must be abandoned for safety reasons. Originally built on a landfill and designed to settle slightly over time, the facility has settled up to 30 inches in some places, far exceeding expectations. As a consequence, water intrusion and uneven settling is compromising the structural integrity and safety of the site.

The Pearl Harbor Memorial Fund is dedicated to making the Pearl Harbor Memorial Museum & Visitor Center a reality.
