#### Friday, April 29

• Flags shipped to Schaghticoke Fairgrounds (availability of flags cannot be guaranteed after this date)

#### Saturday, May 14

• Assembly of flags at the fairgrounds in Arts and Crafts Building; 9:00am to finish (1pm?)

#### Tuesday, May 24

• The field will be marked with field paint indicating where each rebar will be installed.

## Wednesday, May 25

- Rebar (3' lengths) will be driven 1' into the ground, then the flags placed over them. We expect a large group of volunteers to be present including Patriot Guard Riders
- Information tents and portable lights will be installed
- Volunteers will supervise throughout the night beginning this night and going until Sunday night.
- Supervision of the field will occur 24 hours until the flags are removed Monday.

## Thursday, May 26

- Classes with their teachers will be invited to come onto the field, 8:30am to 3:00pm
- Daughters of the American Revolution will have gift flags for children in Pre-K through 4<sup>th</sup> grade. They will have activities throughout the school day for all grades
- Veterans will be available to talk to students

- Flags removed throughout the day
- By 9:00pm all flags will be removed

- Tents, lights and generators will be removed
- Grounds will be checked for complete removal of all material
