The Inaugural Berks County Field of Honor® was dedicated on July 3, 2023. A display of 180 U.S. Flags is flying over the Wyomissing Stone House Pond until July 8, 2023. Each of the Flags represents an individual and tells a story. Flags are dedicated to honor individuals currently serving in our Active-Duty Military, Fallen Servicemen & Women, First Responders, Heroes in Our Lives, Veterans & Hometown Heroes.

The West Reading-Wyomissing Rotary Club was looking for a service project to bring the community together in a patriotic tribute to honor our heroes. The Stars & Stripes reminds us of who we are as a people. Americans meet the challenges of history and overcome hardships becoming stronger. That is who we are. The United States flag represents our solidarity in creating a brighter tomorrow and uniting us all.

That was the theme of the Dedication Ceremony that included the Presentation of Colors by Berks County Sheriff Honor Guard, William Tobin - Berks County Veterans Affairs leading the Pledge of Allegiance and the National Anthem performed by Eagle Scout Benjamin Small. After a moment of Silence/Reflection and the playing of Taps, the Ribbon was cut to dedicate the Field of Honor®.
